

## Supplement to the Information for Students as of November 20, 2020

In connection with the extension of the emergency state until December 23, 2020, the **validity** of the accommodation conditions specified in the document "Information for accommodated students at BUT Halls of Residence" as of November 20, 2020 is **extended**, namely:

- **until the end of the emergency state or another equivalent regime** set by a measure of a public authority authorized to manage the epidemiological situation in the Czech Republic or in the South Moravian Region, **but no later than by December 31, 2020, 23:59.**

Until the specified date, students can **check out** from the halls of residence and terminate the Accommodation Agreement according to the standard conditions.

**Starting from January 1, 2021**, at the latest until the end of the winter semester (determined by the internal rules of BUT and individual faculties), in case of students who leave their **personal belongings** in the rooms, the dormitory price **is set at 60%** of the dormitory fee.

In case if:

- the student accommodated in the academic year 2020/21 will not check out from the halls of residence, so after the student's return to the dormitory and the use of accommodation, the standard amount of the dormitory fee is renewed, **from the date of arrival, in the full amount;**
- the Accommodation Agreement is terminated, students accommodated in the academic year 2020/21 are **guaranteed to be provided with accommodation**, but without the right to maintain the original location;
- the student **leaves** the halls of residence; he/she can use the possibility of accommodation **for the necessary time for the same dormitory fee** as at the respective halls of residence;

**Booking accommodation in AY 2021/2022** If you have concluded an Accommodation Agreement in AY 2020/2021 when booking accommodation in AY 2021/2022, you will proceed according to the Rules for Accommodation of Students and Employees (published on the Halls of Residence and Canteens website) as an accommodated student.

It is assumed that if an emergency state is not declared in the Czech Republic at the time of the beginning of the summer semester, the amount of the dormitory fee for students who leave their personal belongings in the halls of residence will be 100%; otherwise, the dormitory price of 60% according to the Accommodation Agreement will be still applied.
