Device selection

BUT has 17 catering facilities -canteens, faculty restaurants and buffets, as well as a modern conceived pizzeria. The range of cafeterias and restaurants consists of ready-made meals, fast dishes (including meatless and sweet meals), baguettes, salads, desserts, fruit, drinks, etc. One packed portion of ready-made meals is also offered for take away. The assortment of pizzeria and café-bar is much wider and offers an above-standard environment.

Opening hours of individual facilities are adapted to customers - classic canteens are opened for lunch and dinner, faculty restaurants during lessons, caffè-bar and pizzeria from morning till 9 p.m.

Menu selection

Classical canteens have a daily choice of up to eight main meals. Mozzarella Pizzeria and Rybkova Restaurant offer a relatively constant assortment including a menu. → Cost Of Living

The cost of living in the Czech Republic is much lower than in the old EU member states and you will be able to live comfortably without spending large sums.

The Czech crown (in Czech "koruna"), abbreviated as Kč (CZK) is the official currency of the Czech Republic. The crown is formally divided into hellers (haléř), which are no longer in use. They are shown in prices and rounded off to the nearest crown. The approximate conversion rate is 100 CZK / 3,80 EUR or 26 CZK / 1 EUR. Used coins are 1 CZK, 2 CZK, 5 CZK, 10 CZK, 20 CZK and 50 CZK; used banknotes are 100 CZK, 200 CZK, 500 CZK, 1 000 CZK, 2 000 CZK and 5 000 CZK. Although the Euro is occasionally accepted by some restaurants, hotels and shops, the Czech crown is generally the only currency that can be used. Most supermarkets, shops, restaurants and institutions accept payment cards. There are many cash machines located especially in the city centre and in the campus.

→ Student Cards

Isic - International Student Identity Card

- You should obtain your Student Identity Card (ISIC) at your home university or in your home country.
- ISIC will allow you to benefit from student reductions for such things as the public transport pass, most museum and theatre tickets, and many bus, rail and air fares
- If for some reason you are not able to do so before coming to the Brno University of Technology, it is possible to apply for the ISIC in Brno at Student Agency, Náměstí Svobody 17, Brno. You have to pay a fee 350 CZK. You will need a confirmation of studies which you get from your faculty coordinator.

ESNCard

- The ESN Card is the membership card of the Erasmus Student Network.
- The ESN Card is valid for 12 months and only valid with a photo and correct personal data. The card is strictly personal and can be used only by the card holder.
- You can get the ESN card if you have been an international student, if you are currently on exchange, or if you are active member of ESN VUT section.
- You can obtain the card at Panda Point (block A03 on Pod Palackého vrchem dormitories) any time during opening hours, or you can contact ESN VUT on social networks.

But Student Identity Card

- When you are enrolled at university you will get a student identity card with a special BUT chip.
- This card will serve you as your identification card while you are at Brno University of Technology - it will enable you to enter computer rooms at faculties or in the university center, department or central libraries, and other university facilities.
- You can benefit from the student reductions available at student canteens, public transport, etc.

→ Where can you study?

The Brno University of Technology has paid great attention to the establishment and equipment of libraries and computing centre. They are all open to students and staff in the university centre, at faculties and at dormitories.

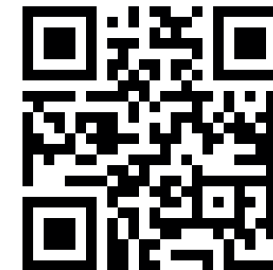

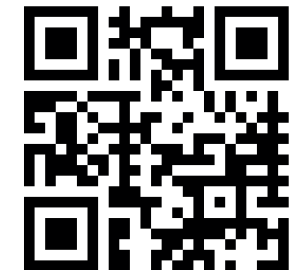

Centre of sports activities of Brno university of technology (cesa) Physical education and sport

CESA BUT is a department for the whole University of Technology in Brno which arranges Physical education and sport for students, employees, foreign students studying in English language and as well students of short-term stay at all the faculties of Brno University of Technology. At the same time CESA BUT

is responsible for training of subjects of the discipline Management in Physical culture which is taught at Business faculty.

CESA aims at a high-quality physical education process and equal approach of all the students to Physical education and sports activities.

Philosophy of healthy life style and active life of students serves as a basis for work of CESA including presentation and propagation of physical activities supporting health.

Physical education is a facultative subject and it can be attended by regular students of bachelor or master's studies. Students of doctoral studies and foreign students can take part in these lessons as well. Semestral lessons of Physical education (facultative PE) are held for all the students of all the faculties and all the grades together. In instructional programs of each sport the groups of students are made according to their performance from beginners

to top sportsmen and BUT representation. Healthy physical activities play a very important role in instructional programs of Physical education (Physio program, Fitness not only for women, Fitness body-building, Fitness workout, Massage, Regeneration etc.)

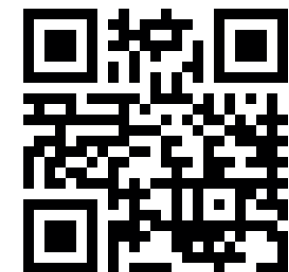
Registration for the facultative subject Physical education is always electronic in the first week of winter and summer semester. Students are allowed to register for 2 lessons (2 registrations) in each semester free of charge. More lessons than is the framework of study programme is not free of charge. **Some sports of basic offer organized by other subjects are not free of charge too. Charge of these sports is published in the Sports offer.** Students who want to attend sports and physical activities in Czech language can find information about the offer of each individual sports specialization and courses including annotations on www.cesa.vutbr.cz.

Foreign students of short-term stay can either use the sports offer in English language or join sports activities together with Czech students. Registration for the first possibility on www.cesa.vutbr.cz/studium/erasmus-sport. Registration for the Czech groups is possible to make by using ICS club or CESA worker who is responsible for registration of foreign students (Václav Kundera, office at Sport center Machina, kundera@cesa.vutbr.cz). Registration must always be completed in the first two weeks of the semester.

Accommodation scholarship

Students are entitled to receive the accommodation scholarship if they are:

- students enrolled to Bachelor, Master and Doctoral programme

Students can apply for an accommodation scholarship online. The instructions how to apply for the accommodation scholarship will be provided to all students by e-mail in the beginning of semester after their arrival. The scholarship is paid to students to their student bank account in CZK.

→ Insurance

EU CITIZENS (incl. Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland, Switzerland)

It is the responsibility of each student to have their health insurance for their stay in the Czech Republic. Each student have to bring along a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).

It is recommended to register at Czech health insurance company (e. g. General Health Insurance Company „VZP“, Maxima pojistovna, Slavia pojistovna etc.), but not obligatory. Registration at VZP **is free of charge** and covers costs by doctor. You get a personal health insurance number, you should show to doctors or in hospital (Certificate of Registration).

NON EU CITIZENS

NON EU citizens also have the obligation to arrange the health insurance, which complies to the Czech law requirements. The obligatory has to be fulfilled within visa application. It is recommended to choose the provider of the health insurance (e.g. General Health Insurance Company „VZP“, Maxima pojistovna, Slavia pojistovna etc.) and register there. Registration at Czech health insurance company covers costs by doctor.

Students from EU countries (incl. Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Iceland)

In case you stay in a private accommodation you have to register at Czech Foreign Police within 30 days after your arrival.

Students from NON EU countries (long-term visa, over 90 days)

In case you stay in halls of residence you do not have to register at Czech Foreign Police (dormitory provider will register you).

In case you stay in a private accommodation you have to register at Czech Foreign Police within 3 working days after your arrival.

Students from NON EU countries (long term residence permit)

In case you stay in halls of residence or in a private accommodation you have to register at OAMP (Department for Asylum and Migration Policy) within 3 working days.
